Part- I



The University

Backdrop

Lalit Narayan Mithila University Kameshwaranagar, Darbhanga is the fruition of long cherished desire of the people of Mithilanchal. Eminent academicians like Dr. Amarnath Jha, Dr. R. C. Mazumdar, Dr. A. S. Altekar, Dr. Sunil Kumar Chatterjee and the likes expressed their views in favour of the establishment of a contemporary University at Darbhanga.

The necessity of a University was also voiced time and again on the floors of the state legislature and in the parliament. Eventually, on 27th January, 1947, which also happened to be the auspicious occasion of Vasant Panchami, at a meeting of some of the leading citizens of Darbhanga following the visit of Late Prof. Binodanand Jha, the then Health and L. S. G. Minister, Government of Bihar, the Mithila University Committee was constituted. The ordinating committee constituted Dr. Amarnath Jha as the President, Pandit Girindra Mohan Mishra and Pandit Gangadhar Mishra as the Vice-Presidents, Pandit Harinath Mishra as the General Secretary, Kumar Kalyan Lal and Professor Quasim Hussain as Secretaries, and Late Shri Padmana Prasad as the Treasurer including a few members such as Shri Jyoti Prasad Singh, the late Shri P. N. Mishra and Principal B. M. K. Sinha.

The year 1968 proved to be landmark year in the history of the University when a team from UGC visited Darbhanga in order to explore the possibilities of establishing a multi-faculty University here. Subsequently the State Government set up a committee to examine the administrative and academic structure of the intended University at Darbhanga, following the recommendations made by the visiting team of the U.G.C.

Establishment

The Government of India constituted another committee consisting of Shri T. P. Singh, Secretary, Minister of Education and Social Welfare, Shri R. K. Chabra, Secretary U.G.C. and Shri N. D. J. Rao, Education Commissioner, Bihar to look into the matters. The committee's report strongly recommending the establishment of a separate and independent University at Darbhanga commenced the germination process. Considering its socio-economic background, the Mithila University was established in Darbhanga by an ordinance in 1972.



The Name

After the sad demise of Pt. Lalit Narayan Mishra the then Union Railway Minister, in January, 1975, the name of Mithila University was amended as Lalit Narayan Mithila University. But it was soon reversed to the original name through an ordinance. However, in 1980, the name Lalit Narayan Mithila University was restored through another Ordinance.

Territorial Jurisdiction

Colleges of Darbhanga and Kosi Divisions, from the then two Universities, Bihar University, Muzaffarpur and Bhagalpur University, Bhagalpur formed a part of the fresh sapling. However, colleges of Kosi Division which were initially part of this University, were transferred to newly established B. N. Mandal University, Laloo Nagar, Madhepura, with vertical separation of the assets and liabilities with effect from 01.01.1992.

The Lalit Narayan Mithila University is one of the prime institutions for providing higher education in Bihar. The LNMU campus is spread across 230 acres and has modern buildings and student services. The university's students in the Arts, Commerce, and Science streams can take undergraduate and graduate courses, such as B Ed, B. Sc. M. Sc and MA. At the university, there are also many diploma and research programs.

The Campus





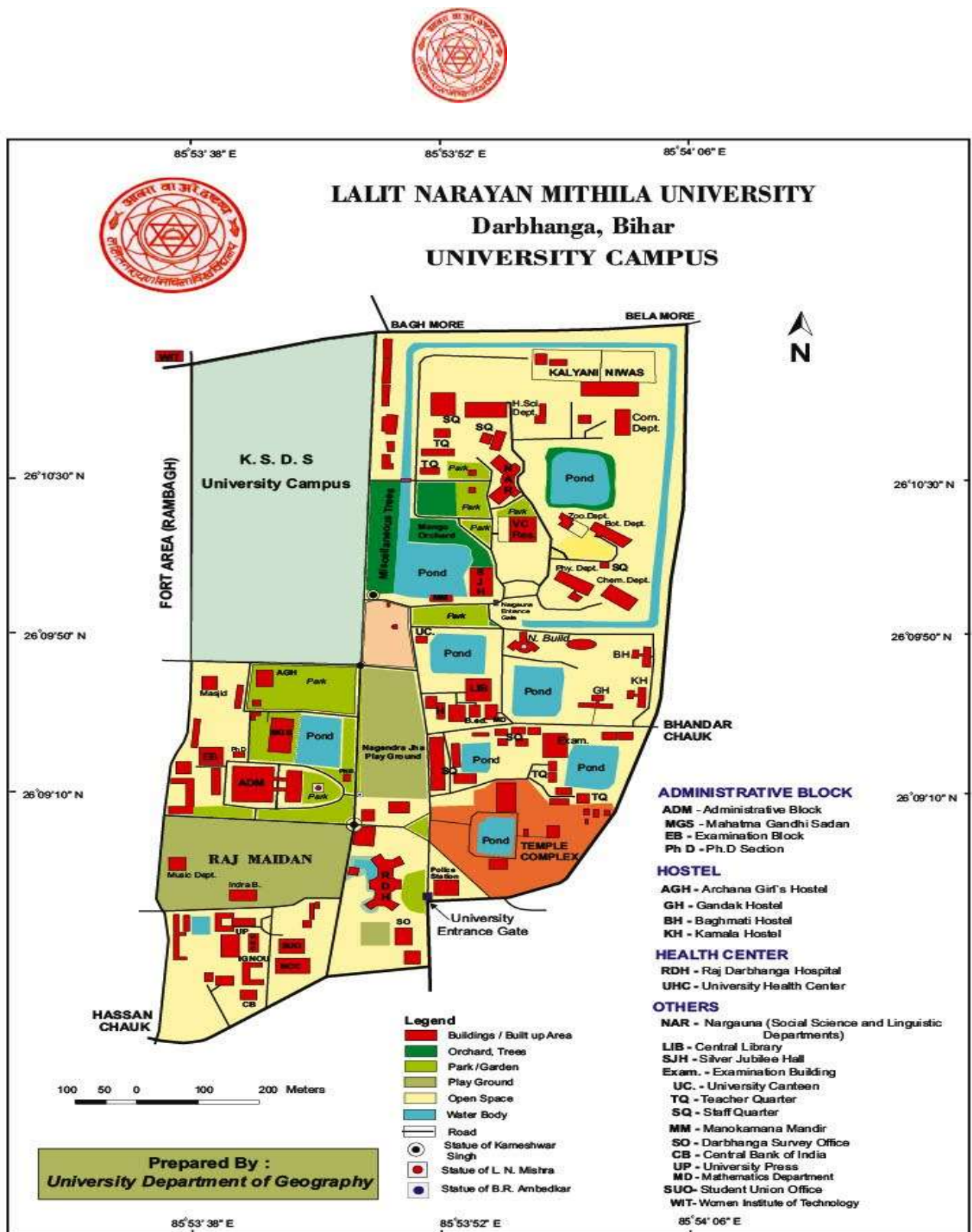

UGC Recognition

In 1986 the University got recognition from University Grants Commission (UGC) of India under section 12 (A) of the UGC Act. Since February 1989 the University is getting institutional development grants under section 12(B) of the UGC Act.



Distance Education

The Directorate of Distance Education in the university was established in year 1998 vide University Letter No. P/D 54-139/96, dated 07.02.1998. Dr. Harendra Singh the then controller of examination, L.N. Mithila University, Darbhanga was the First Director in-charge of the Directorate of Distance Education. He formulated and prepared a proposal for starting Distance Education.

The Directorate finally became functional and operative in 2005 with the launching of B.Ed. Programme in collaboration with IGNOU. In 2020, the Distance Education Bureau (DEB) of UGC allowed L N Mithila University (LNMU) in Bihar to admit students to some courses recognized by it. The Directorate is now offering U.G., P.G., B.Lis., M.Lis and Professional Programmes like B.Ed. (ODL) as well as B.Ed. in regular mode with the approval of U.G.C.-DEB, N.C.T.E. and State of Bihar Government.

However, at present, the Directorate is no longer functional.

NAAC Accreditation and Assessment

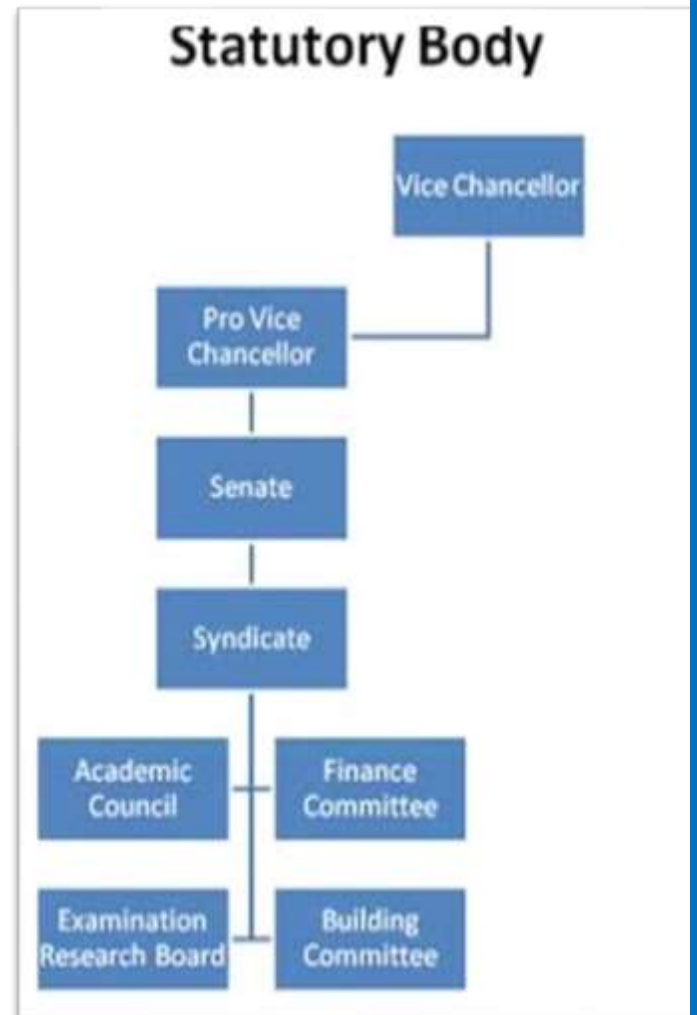

The University is participating in NIRF Ranking. This year the university participated in 3rd term in NIRF.

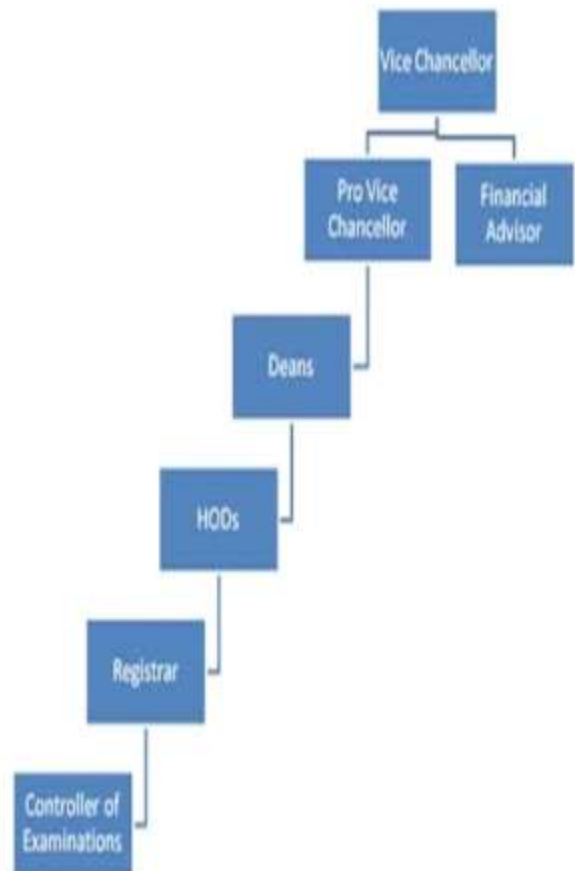


Organisational Structure

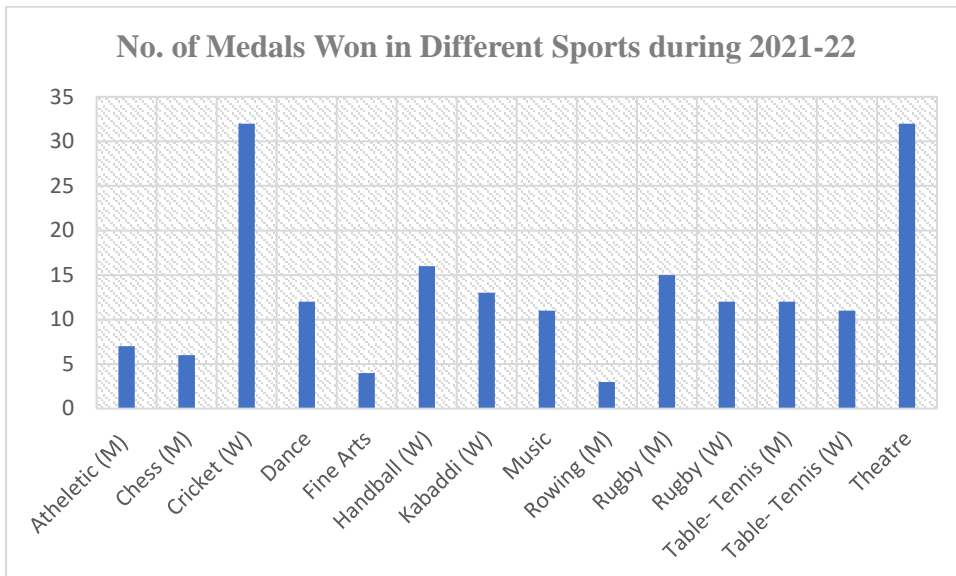

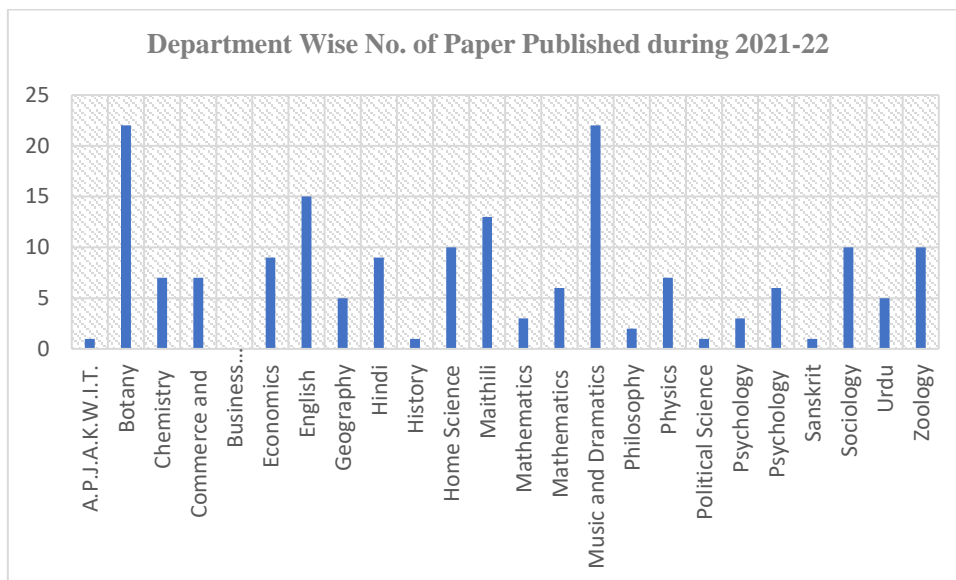

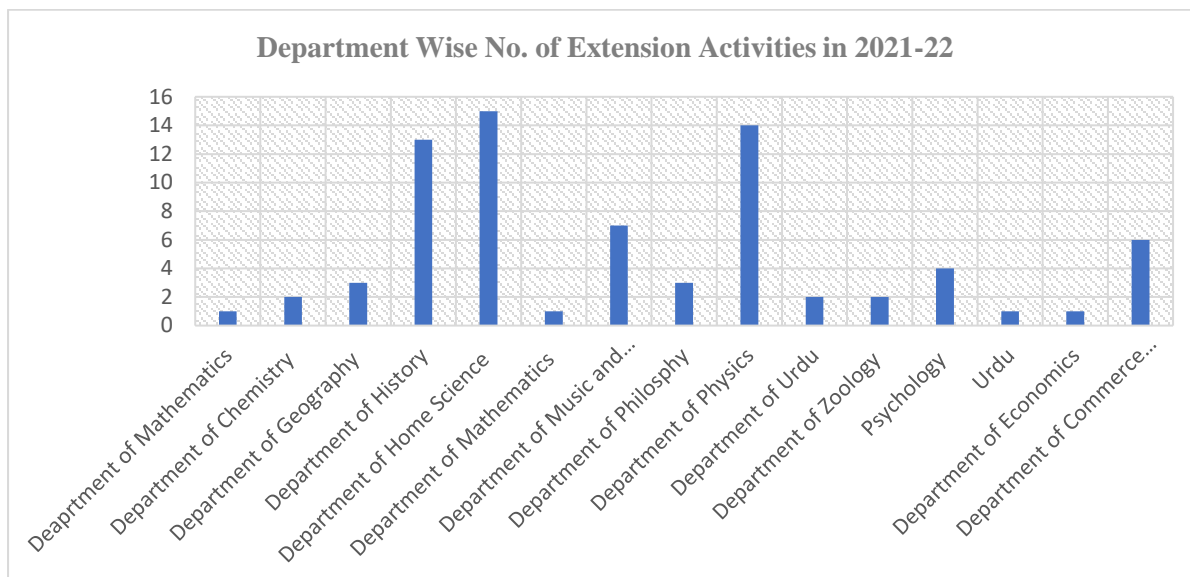

मान्यवर!

पिछलीवार दिनांक 19.12.2020 को हमलोग इसी सदन में मिले थे और साथ में मिलकर कई निर्णय लिये थे। शैक्षणिक एवं शोध-परक कई सपने देखे थे। इनमें से कुछ पूरे



हो सके और कई प्रक्रियाधीन हैं। वर्ष 2020 के मार्च से प्रारंभ COVID-19 वैश्विक महामारी का समापन अभी तक नहीं हो सका है और हमारे प्रयासों में इसके कारण अनेकों व्यवधान भी आये हैं। आज की ही बैठक की बात करें तो निर्णय तो हमने माननीय सदस्यों के भौतिक उपस्थिति के साथ करने का लिया था, किन्तु गृह-विभाग एवं शिक्षा विभाग द्वारा जारी दिशा-निर्देशों तथा "कोरोना-प्रसार" की वर्तमान लहर के मद्देनजर आज की बैठक "ऑन-लाईन" की जा रही है। ऐसा करने का उद्देश्य सिर्फ और सिर्फ माननीय सदस्यों के स्वास्थ्य को अक्षुण्ण रखना ही है।

माननीय सदस्यगण!

पिछली बैठक के बाद किये गये कार्यों और प्रस्तावित कार्यों का संक्षिप्त विवरण मैं निम्न रूप में आपके समक्ष प्रस्तुत कर रहा हूँ :-

- विश्वविद्यालय स्नातकोत्तर सभी विभागों में छात्रों एवं शिक्षकों की सुविधा हेतु वर्गों की संख्या बढ़ाने की व्यवस्था की जा रही है इसी क्रम में 60 कमरों पर आधारित एक एकेडमिक ब्लॉक के निर्माण की योजना है।
- विश्वविद्यालय स्नातकोत्तर सभी विभागों में अब तक कुल 61 राष्ट्रीय सेमिनार एवं 12 अंतर्राष्ट्रीय सेमिनार के साथ ही अन्य कुल 103 प्रतिस्पर्धाएँ आयोजित की गई हैं।
- विश्वविद्यालय के इतिहास में पहली बार अंगीभूत महाविद्यालय एवं संबद्ध महाविद्यालय के सेवानिवृत्त शिक्षकों को "शिक्षक दिवस" के मौके पर सम्मानित किया गया।
- ऐतिहासिक धरोहर को संरक्षित करने की दिशा में महात्मा गांधी सदन का जीर्णोद्धार कराया जा रहा है एवं राष्ट्रपिता महात्मा गाँधी जी की नई कांस्य-प्रतिमा स्थापित की गयी है।
- ऐतिहासिक गाँधी संग्रहालय को पुनः गतिशील बनाते हुए केंद्रीय पुस्तकालय में महात्मा गांधी जी के जीवन पर आधारित लिखी पुस्तक का विशेष संग्रह केंद्र स्थापित किया जा रहा है।
- गांधी सदन के सामने स्थित तालाब का सौंदर्यीकरण कराया गया है।
- "स्वच्छ कैंपस सुंदर कैंपस" के तहत पूरे कैंपस की साफ-सफाई की विशेष व्यवस्था है एवं आगंतुक हेतु तालाब के सामने पार्क बनाने की प्रक्रिया की जा रही है।
- पूरे कैंपस में अलग-अलग जगहों पर जीर्ण-शीर्ण स्थिति में पड़े सड़क का नवीनीकरण किया गया है।



- शोधार्थियों की सुविधा हेतु कोरोना महामारी को ध्यान में रखते हुए ऑनलाइन पीएच0-डी0 मौखिकी की परीक्षा का आयोजन किया जा रहा है।
- शोध की गुणवत्ता बढ़ाने हेतु Anti-plagiarism पॉलिसी को अडॉप्ट करते हुए एक सेल का गठन किया गया है।
- विश्वविद्यालय मुख्यालय में कार्यालय की जगह की कमी को ध्यान में रखते हुए अधिकतर कार्यालयों को नए भवन में सुविधाओं से युक्त कर के शिफ्ट किया गया है।
- सभी कार्यालयों को इंफ्रास्ट्रक्चर की सुविधा उपलब्ध कराई गई है।
- विश्वविद्यालय मुख्यालय एवं स्नातकोत्तर विभागों के सभी कार्यालयों में वाई-फाई की सुविधा उपलब्ध कराई गई, जिससे शिक्षकों को ऑनलाइन क्लासेज लेने में सुविधा हो पाई है।
- अंतर्राष्ट्रीय स्तर का मैदान बनाने हेतु भारत सरकार को "खेलो इंडिया प्रोजेक्ट" के तहत प्रस्ताव भेजा गया है।
- विश्वविद्यालय मुख्यालय एवं स्नातकोत्तर विभाग में शुद्ध पेयजल की व्यवस्था की गई है।
- स्थापना के 50वें वर्ष में प्रवेश के अवसर पर विश्वविद्यालय एवं इसके अंतर्गत महाविद्यालयों में पूरे साल कार्यक्रम आयोजन करने का निर्णय लिया गया है।
- सरकार के निर्देशानुसार एससी-एसटी हेतु "सेंटर ऑफ एक्सीलेंस" की स्थापना की जा रही है।
- भारत सरकार के निर्देश पर विश्वविद्यालय में "जनगणना संग्रह केंद्र" की स्थापना की जा रही है।
- लंबित प्रक्रिया से रुके हुए आश्रितों को अनुकंपा के तहत नियुक्ति के लिए कई बैठकों का आयोजन कर संपादित किया गया। इसके तहत दो चरणों में कुल 58 पाल्यों को अनुकंपा के आधार पर नौकरी दी गई है।
- विश्वविद्यालय परिसर में स्थित सभी महापुरुषों के स्मारकों को विशेष सम्मान देते हुए सभी महापुरुषों की प्रतिमाओं के ऊपर छतरी का निर्माण कराया गया है।
- बिहार कॉमन एंट्रेंस टेस्ट की सूची में डॉक्टर अब्दुल कलाम विमेंस इंस्टिट्यूट ऑफ टेक्नोलॉजी को जोड़ा गया है, जिससे इस संस्था के उन्नयन में सहयोग मिलेगा।
- विश्वविद्यालय की सभी परीक्षाओं को त्वरित गति से संपन्न कराया जा रहा है, जिससे सत्र नियमित किया जा सके। आप सबों के लिए यह सूचना हर्षकारी है कि इस विकट समय में भी हमारा विश्वविद्यालय राज्य का एकमात्र विश्वविद्यालय है जिसने डिग्री पार्ट-3 परीक्षा 2021 का आयोजन कर परीक्षाफल प्रकाशित कर दिया है।
- विश्वविद्यालय के सभी निकायों से अनुमोदित करते हुए राजभवन के दिशा निर्देश से राज्य उच्चतर शिक्षा विभाग पटना को स्ववित्तपोषित योजना के तहत कुल 34 विषयों की



मान्यता प्राप्त करने हेतु प्रस्ताव भेजा जा चुका है। जल्द ही इन सभी विषयों में नामांकन प्रक्रिया प्रारंभ की जाएगी।

- विश्वविद्यालय के 50 वर्षों के इतिहास में पहली बार सेवानिवृत्त शिक्षकेतर कर्मियों को 25 सितम्बर के दिन सम्मानित किए जाने की योजना सुनिश्चित की गयी है।
- राजभवन के दिशा निर्देश पर महाविद्यालयों के ऑटोमेशन हेतु कई कार्य करने की योजना है, जिसमें से विश्वविद्यालय हेतु UMIS लागू किया गया है।
- पिछले 20 वर्षों से जीर्ण-शीर्ण स्थिति में पड़े टेबलेटिंग रजिस्टर को यू0एम0आई0एस0 के अंतर्गत डिजिटल करने की प्रक्रिया प्रारंभ की गई है।
- कुल 5 विषयों में शिक्षकों की प्रोन्नति की गई है एवं शेष विषयों में प्रक्रियाधीन है।
- विश्वविद्यालयों के इतिहास में पहली बार स्नातक में नामांकन हेतु लगभग 1,38,350 छात्रों की चयन सूची एक बार में ही प्रकाशित की गई है। साथ ही बिहार का यह पहला विश्वविद्यालय है जहाँ नामांकन के साथ-साथ पंजीयन एवं परीक्षा-प्रपत्र भरने का निर्णय लिया गया है। जिससे भविष्य में होने वाली सभी प्रकार की समस्याओं से विश्वविद्यालय एवं छात्र-छात्राओं को छुटकारा मिलेगा।
- सुरक्षा के दृष्टिकोण से पूरे कैंपस एवं कार्यालयों में सी.सी.टी.वी. कैमरे लगाए गए हैं।
- एक वर्ष के अन्दर 02 राज्य स्तरीय बी0एड0 की दो-वर्षीय कोर्स के लिए टेस्ट परीक्षा एवं चार-वर्षीय इन्टिग्रेटेड कोर्स के लिए टेस्ट परीक्षा का सफल आयोजन किया गया।
